

What's Happening at the Ward Museum

Both the Drop in Art and Drop in Art Jr. programs are funded in part by the Susan K. Black Foundation. Through the foundation we are providing free art supply kits monthly for both programs.

Drop in Art Jr. – (1 – 5 years) Every Wednesday a new nature-based story and craft are released. Free supply kits are available at the beginning of every month. You can pick up the kits in the Museum Lobby during museum hours. Masks are mandatory.

Drop in Art – (all ages) Every 3rd Saturday we invite a local artist to teach their craft. Free supply kits are available beginning the week prior to the event. You can pick up the kits in the Museum Lobby during museum hours. Masks are mandatory. Visit the website for the craft of the month.

“Flock Around the Block” bird walks – (geared towards 1st – 5th grades) The Ward Museum in Partnership with several local community centers will have bird walks on the first and third Wednesdays and Saturdays of the month.
